What to Do If Someone Dies in Hospital

If a loved one dies in hospital, here's what happens and what you need to do:

## 1. Hospital staff will confirm the death

A doctor will officially confirm the person has died. They'll take care of the first steps, so you don't h

#### 2. You'll be informed

The hospital will contact the next of kin. If you're not there when it happens, they'll let you know and

# 3. You'll get the Medical Certificate

This certificate shows the cause of death. You'll need it to register the death. The hospital will eithe

### 4. Ask about viewing and collecting belongings

You can usually see your loved one in the hospital's chapel of rest. Ask staff about personal items

#### 5. Choose a funeral director

Once the hospital gives clearance, the funeral director can collect the body and take over care.

### 6. Register the death

You must register the death within 5 days. Contact the local Register Office. Bring:

- The Medical Certificate
- ID and personal details of the person who died

#### 7. Take care of other things

Let people and services know — like banks, the DWP, and the local council. The hospital may help
